Directions to the California History Center at De Anza College

Address: De Anza College, 21250 Stevens Creek Blvd., Cupertino 95014

From 280, take Highway 85 South towards Gilroy (next off ramp after the De Anza Blvd. off ramp). Take the Stevens Creek Blvd. exit and stay as far over to the right as you can and still be able to make a left turn on to Stevens Creek. Make a left turn on to Stevens Creek Blvd, cross back over 85 – you will see the campus to your right. Make a right turn into the campus at the off ramp entrance area right under the electronic marquee sign, and go to your right. You will see a parking structure building to your right as you make the sharp turn. Make a right turn into the Flint Center Parking Structure. Park and walk out of the structure headed south. **PARKING PERMITS:** will be available to those who register in advance...come to the registration desk and we will give you a permit to put in your car. You may also purchase your own permit from one of the permit kiosks.

You will see a single story, stucco building we call the “cottage” in desperate need of restoration just in front of you, with the Flint Center to your left. Go around the cottage building on either side and you will see a white building with white columns that doesn’t fit in with any of the other structures just beyond the cottage – that’s the California History Center (CHC). Enter through the front doors.

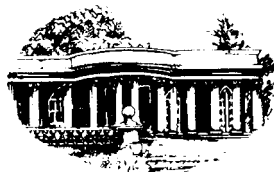
